

IMD 2010 LSOA Domain Score Summaries

Health and Disability

Over half the town (58%) is in the top 10% most deprived for Health and Disability and 17% is in the top 1%. 1 LSOA is ranked 2nd worst out of 32,482 LSOA's in England.

The most deprived 1% nationally: Ayresome, Beckfield, Beechwood, Clairville, Coulby Newham, Middlehaven, North Ormesby, Pallister, Thorntree and University and small part of Beechwood. Surprisingly there is a small part of Coulby Newham fall into the top 1% most deprived nationally for Health and Disability.

However there are some pockets of improvements, dispersed fairly evenly across the town.

Employment

The majority of the borough has seen an improved ranking for this domain. Including parts of East Middlesbrough. However nearly half the town (45%) is still in the top 10% most deprived for Employment and 6% in the top 1%.

Areas in the top 1% most deprived for employment are small part of Beechwood, small part of Thorntree and parts of Middlehaven. However areas that have seen the most improvement are part of Beckfield, Aclam, Hemlington and Middlehaven

Crime

Of the 88 LSOA's in Middlesbrough 9% are in the top 1% and 43% in the top 10% for crime.

The most deprived areas, ranked in the bottom 1% nationally, are scattered across parts of Ayresome, Park, Middlehaven, Pallister, Clairville and a small parts of North Ormesby ward. Most of the 13 deprived wards still rank in the most deprived 10% nationally for crime.

However 81% of all LSOA's in the borough has seen significant improvement in rank for the crime domain since 2007. Areas that have significantly improved are all of the Beckfield ward, parts of Thorntree, Pallister, Park, Clairville, Beechwood and the majority of Gresham

Income

40% of the town is in the top 10% most deprived for Income and 9% in the top 1%

The most deprived 1% includes parts of Thorntree, part of Clairville, small part of Pallister and Middlehaven.

High levels of Income deprivation continue to dominate east Middlesbrough and Middlehaven, University and Gresham. There are pockets of improvements in Income deprivation spread throughout the town.

Education, Skills and Training

Nearly 40% of the town is still in the top 10% most deprived for Education, Skills and Training and 6% in the top 1%.

The top 1% is predominantly in the wards of Thorntree, Clairville, Pallister and parts of Middlehaven.

However the majority of the borough has improved its rank for this domain since 2007 especially in parts of Thorntree, Park End, Beckfield and Brambles Farm.

Living Environment

The town fares better for Living Environment with 12% in the top 10% and only 1% in the top 1%.

The top 1% is in Gresham ward and the 10% is Middlehaven, Gresham, and small part of University and North Ormesby

A small part of University ward has shown significant improvement

Barriers to Housing and Services

Of all the domains this one is showing the least deprivation. The only Middlesbrough LSOA in the most deprived 10% nationally is the northern part of Marton ward, encompassing the area around Stewart Park.

Much of the town is relatively unchanged since 2007.
