



Middlesbrough Volunteering Star Awards 2010

Categories and Guidance for Nominations

Categories:

1	Young Star	Individual award for volunteers aged 14 – 25 years old who have made a difference in Middlesbrough through volunteering <i>Please state if this volunteer is working with vinvolved- you may need to ask them this question.</i>
2	Adult Star	Individual award for volunteers aged 26 – 60 years old who have made a difference in Middlesbrough through volunteering
3	Senior Star	Individual award for volunteers aged 61 and over who have made a difference in Middlesbrough through volunteering
4	Individual Star	A person of any age who has volunteered despite difficult personal circumstances
5	Star Trustee	A volunteer whose contribution as a trustee has made a positive impact on their organisation
6	Star Community / Voluntary Group	A voluntary group whose project or service has made a significant impact on their community
	Long Service Stars:	Volunteers who have given specific years of service, whether for one organisation or for several:
7	5 Year Star	
8	10 Year Star	
9	20 Year Star	
10	30 Year Star	
11	Star Organisation	An organisation nominated by their volunteers as being a great place to volunteer

Guidance:

Middlesbrough Volunteering Star Awards is open to volunteers, groups and organisations that operate within Middlesbrough.

- Nominations in categories 1 to 10 can be made by any representative of an organisation that involves volunteers.
- Organisations nominating individuals for awards are requested to restrict their nominations to a **maximum of three** people in each category.
- To qualify for individual awards, nominees should be actively volunteering at 30th June 2010
- Nominations in category 11 should be made by individual volunteers. You will need to let your volunteers know that you may nominate them and also that they can nominate your organisation
- We ask also that you let volunteers know that in order to nominate them you will need to pass their contact details to us.

**Nominations must be received by 12 noon 30th July 2010.
We regret we will not be able to accept late entries.**

All those nominated will receive a certificate of recognition. After selection by a panel of judges, winning individuals and organisations will be invited to attend the awards on 25th October 2010. Further details will follow.
