Knowledge Mobilisation Lead, You've Got This

Thank you for your interest in the post of Knowledge Mobilisation Lead post with You've Got This – the Sport England Place Partnership in South Tees, taking a whole system approach to increasing physical activity at population level across our place, Redcar & Cleveland and Middlesbrough.

The You've Got This vision is 'Active Lives as a Way of Life'. To realise the vision, the programme focuses on organisational level change, building a value of physical activity and embedding whole system approaches.

The salary for the post is NJC points 30-32, with a starting salary of £40,777. MVDA will match employee pension contributions up to 6%. The full-time working week is 35 hours. All new employees benefit from 28 days annual leave (pro rata for part-time staff) in addition to public holidays, rising to a maximum of 30 days after two years continuous service. Your main base will be with You've Got This Programme Team (currently based at Eston Leisure Centre) and you will work occasionally at MVDA offices. You will have the option to work flexibly with a voluntary arrangement around homeworking etc.

Funding is currently secured until December 2027.

Shortlisting will be undertaken against the criteria indicated on the Person Specification. To give yourself the best chance of an interview, you should describe clearly on the application form how you meet each of the criteria.

Please note that we will only consider applications on the standard form: we do not accept CVs. This is to ensure that we have comparable information for all candidates. To further ensure a fair process, the front two pages of the form will be detached and stored separately, so the shortlisting panel will not have access to this information.
