## Culture Recovery Fund: Continuity Support

**Funding Body: Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS)**

**Description:**

Additional funding is available to help secure the future of England's arts and cultural organisations, across all sectors, that have previously been supported by the Culture Recovery Fund in the wake of the coronavirus pandemic.

<b>Status</b>	Open for Applications
<b>Application Deadline</b>	27/08/2021
<b>Maximum Value:</b> Discretionary	<b>Minimum Value:</b> £ 25,000

The total budget for this programme is up to £150 million. Organisations should only apply for the amount they need to get them to a position where they are operating on a viable and sustainable basis by 31 January 2022. The minimum amount that can applied for is £25,000. The Arts Council expects that organisations would not apply for more than 25% per cent of their annual turnover (pre-COVID-19).

The total maximum level of funding that organisations can receive across the three rounds of the Culture Recovery Fund, by sector, is as follows:

- £4 million for not-for-profit organisations.
- £4 million for local authorities or universities.
- £1.5 million for businesses (for-profit organisations or groups).

## Culture Recovery Fund: Emergency Resource Support

**Funding Body:** Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS)

**Description:**

Grants are available for England's cultural organisations, across all sectors, that were previously solvent but now find themselves financially at-risk because of the impacts of coronavirus restrictions.

<b>Status</b>	Open for Applications
<b>Application Deadline</b>	30/09/2021
<b>Maximum Value: £ 3,000,000</b>	<b>Minimum Value: £ 25,000</b>

The budget for the Culture Recovery Fund: Emergency Resource Support programme is £20 million.

Generally, the minimum amount that can be applied for is £25,000 and the maximum is £3 million. For profit-making commercial organisations, the maximum is £1 million.

However, for organisations that have already received a grant from the Culture Recovery Fund, there are limits to how much can be applied for. Non-profit organisations can receive a maximum in total across all rounds of £4 million. For-profit (commercial) organisations can receive a maximum in total across all rounds of £1.5 million.

The Arts Council does not anticipate that awards will be made above and beyond these limits, however, it will, by exception, consider applications which exceed the cumulative limits where applicants can demonstrate that additional funding is necessary for survival.

At the 2021 Budget Review, the Chancellor announced an additional £300 million to support the Culture Recovery Fund(CRF) in 2021 / 2022, to continue to support key cultural organisations as they reopen for their audiences while maintaining COVID-safe spaces and accessibility, and to ensure a vibrant future for the culture sector as the nation recovers from the pandemic.

### Strand Two: Continuity Support

Further information on this strand of the fund and how to apply will be published shortly.

The Government has set cumulative limits on the amount of Culture Recovery funding that can be applied for at £1.5 million for profit-making (commercial) organisations and £4 million for non-profit organisations.

These limits will include any awards made through this Emergency Resource Support programme. This means the total amount of funding to any one applicant, taking account of any awards made through previous Rounds of the Culture Recovery Fund for Independent Cinemas in England plus any subsequent applications to the Emergency Resource Support Programme, must not cumulatively exceed these limits.
